

# St Augustine Bob Doubles

St Augustine Bob Doubles is a useful method to learn when you are learning the singles in Grandsire Doubles.

Each piece of work in St Augustine is exactly the same as what you would do in Grandsire if a single is called.

The position that a single would be called in Grandsire is marked ★ so you can see how the work you do ties in with where you have seen and where you will see the treble.

*Remember though, if you ask to ring St Augustine, there will be no calls!*

Just learn how where you meet the treble tells you each piece of work that you do.

- meet the treble when you are 5ths place → double dodge 4-5 down (dodging with the bell you meet immediately after the treble, treble then takes you off the dodge and hunt straight back to lead)
- meet the treble when you are 3rds place → make long 3rds (note that the second and third blows in 3rds are over the same bell, then pass the treble again, pass the same bell again and lead)
- meet the treble when you are in 4ths place → double dodge 4-5 up (dodging with the bell you meet immediately after the treble, treble takes you off the dodge in your final blow in 5ths, then hunt down to lead)
- meet the treble when you are in 2nds place → make 2nds over the treble and lead again
